



2016 Tree Order Form

City Residents

Order Deadline-October 13, 2016

Completed form can be mailed or dropped off at City Hall – 24 E. Center St. Petersburg, MI 49270

All trees ordered must be within city limits, be planted between the sidewalk and the road (if a sidewalk exists) or be within 33' from the center of the road. There is no limit, except that trees must be no closer than 20' apart and be the same distance from the road as other trees in the right of way.

- After 10/13, Miss Dig will be contacted and then the phone, gas & electric companies will mark the property, indicating any buried utilities.
- You will receive a stake to place on the property in the desired planting location (Not to be placed where the utility lines are marked) Please don't place stakes where recent trees have been removed, due to ground roots. The stake will come with instructions on placement. To create a consistent look throughout your neighborhood, all trees should be placed in a straight line, the same distance from the center of the road.
- Trees will be planted around the end of October.

It is possible that your choice of tree may be out of stock. If this happens you will be contacted and offered another style.
